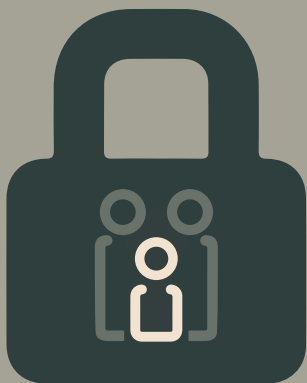


5 KEY QUESTIONS FOR
SUMMER CAMP ENROLLMENT...



5 Key Questions

As you are starting to sign your children up for summer camps and classes, keep in mind that many programs have been hijacked by the same ideologies as public schools. Protect your children by asking these questions.

1. USE OF PRONOUNS

- Do your camp counselors or coaches wear pronoun name tags?
- How do you ensure that my children aren't told that they can be a different sex?

If it's a good program, they'll focus on the purpose of the camp and be clear that it is not their place to address this nonsense. [Pronouns is the first step to a medical transition](#).

2. SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING (SEL)

- Do you practice any [Social Emotional Learning \(SEL\)](#) "competencies"?

If they say they do, ask them specifically what they'll be implementing. If they say things such as "we teach them to collaborate and get along," ask them how that is different from what they did before they called it SEL. Then briefly educate them on [CASEL](#) and what SEL really is.

3. OVERNIGHT POLICIES

- Will my child be supervised by staff members of the same biological sex in their overnight cabins?
- Does the camp permit biological males to share sleeping quarters or communal shower facilities with biological female campers?



3. OVERNIGHT POLICIES Continued

- What is the camp's official policy regarding "gender identity" versus "biological sex" for all housing assignments?
- Will the camp proactively notify parents if a child is placed in a cabin with a counselor or camper of the opposite biological sex?

4. BOOKS AND RESOURCES

- Can I please see the books, activities (i.e., art projects), and resources your counselors will be using?

Often times, camp counselors are young, and they themselves have been indoctrinated in school. Even if they're not outright activists, they will not have the ability to see what is wrong with indoctrination tenets.

5. DIRECTOR / DIRECTOR IN CHARGE

- How long has your Director or Director in charge of camp activities been at your camp?
- What is his or her background?

Do research on this person through social media, LinkedIn, write-ups, etc. Unfortunately, those in education today rarely keep their personal views to themselves as they see it as their duty to influence children to be "social change agents."

The reality for the majority of families is that they cannot homeschool, but parents do not have to send their children to summer programs. If any of the above questions make you uncomfortable, then you should make every effort to ask it.

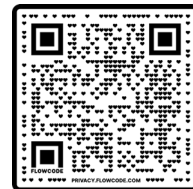


FINAL THOUGHTS
