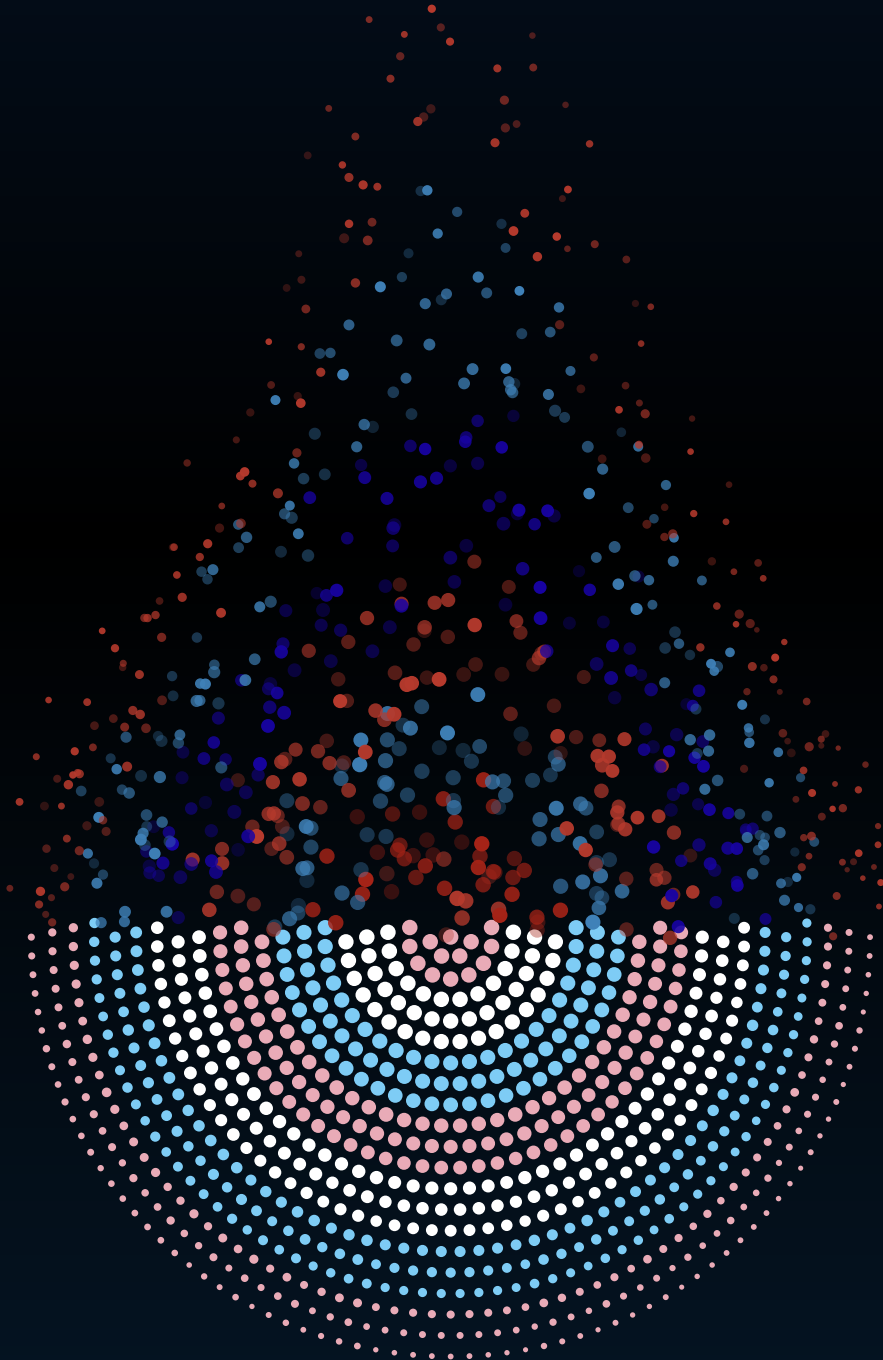

What is an NGO?

Non-Governmental Organizations (NGO) are nonprofit groups who are often funded by local, state, and federal government grants and contracts (taxpayers). NGOs work independent of government control (rules, regulations) to promote social and political change.

Why should parents care?

Unbeknownst to the majority of parents, K-12 public schools are partnering with NGOs, utilizing their services to advance progressive and radical ideologies. This clandestine partnership takes advantage of the "non-partisan" façade these NGOs present, all too often escaping parental notice.

What should parents do?

Contact your principal and formally request a comprehensive roster of all NGOs involved with the school, along with the specific details of the information used to influence your child's education and beliefs.

What is a public/private partnership?

A public-private partnership in education involves a taxpayer-funded public school contracting with a private NGO to provide lessons, training, and curriculum.

However, the school may use the NGO's proprietary status to withhold specific details from parents.

For example:

Corpus Christi ISD spent \$73,288.88 of US taxpayer dollars in September 2021 to purchase SEL curriculum from NGO 'Second Step,' but [denied parents access to the lesson plans](#) citing 'copyright protection.'

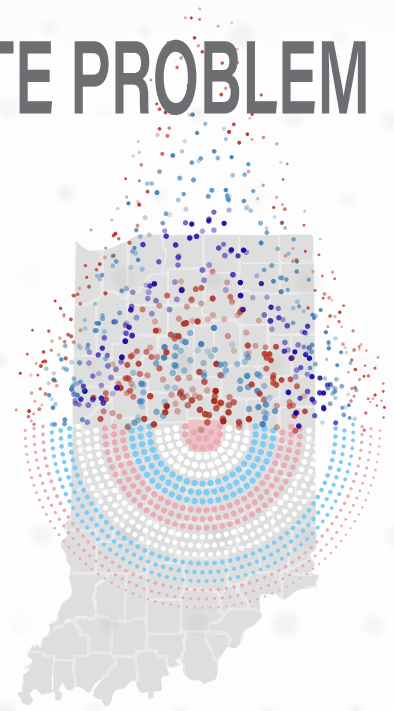

HOW IS INTEGRATION HAPPENING?

WHO IS GENDER SPECTRUM?

A non-governmental organization (**NGO**) that impacts public education without needing to provide transparency to parents.

Gender Spectrum's stated mission:

"the intentional development of gender inclusive school settings"

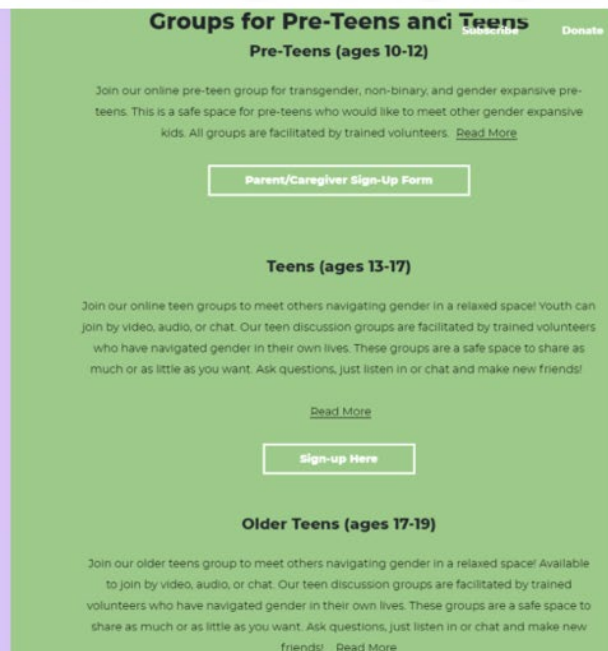
Their core goals are:

1. Systemic integration of gender into schools and curriculum.
2. Strategies to keep Transgender secrets from parents.
3. Ensure conformity for students who do not agree with Transgenderism.

Gender Spectrum provides online chatrooms to children as young 10 years old, where they can share personal information with an unknown adult.



WHAT DOES GENDER SPECTRUM DO?

They train teachers to pass on the **Transgender Social Contagion** and this is how they do it...they layout **four discrete entry points**:

Gender inclusive practices come in many forms. Educators can take a variety of steps today to make their classrooms more gender inclusive.

- *Avoid asking kids to line up as boys or girls or separating them by gender.*
- *Always ask yourself, "Will this create a gendered space?"*
- *Whenever possible, avoid using phrases such as "boys & girls."*

Gender Spectrum's Signage for your Classroom



- *Seek out and use the name and pronouns a student uses, regardless of what is written on their birth certificate.*
- *You can use terms like cisgender, gender-expansive and non-binary and talk about gender diversity as being common across time and culture.*
- *When students share binary gendered statements ideas, provide counter-narratives that challenge them to think more broadly about gender.*



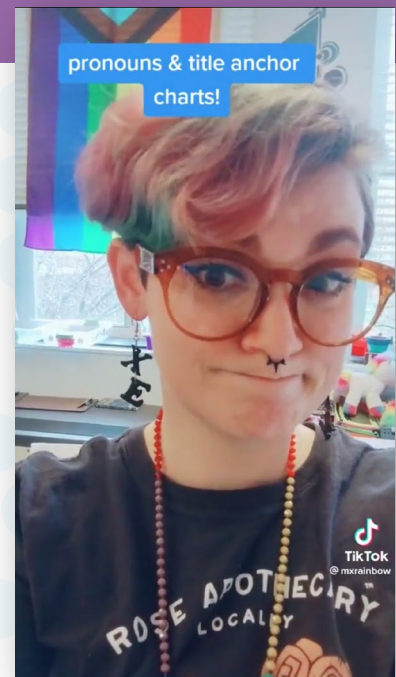

Encouraging Teachers to Correct Student Behavior & "Share Personal Anecdotes"



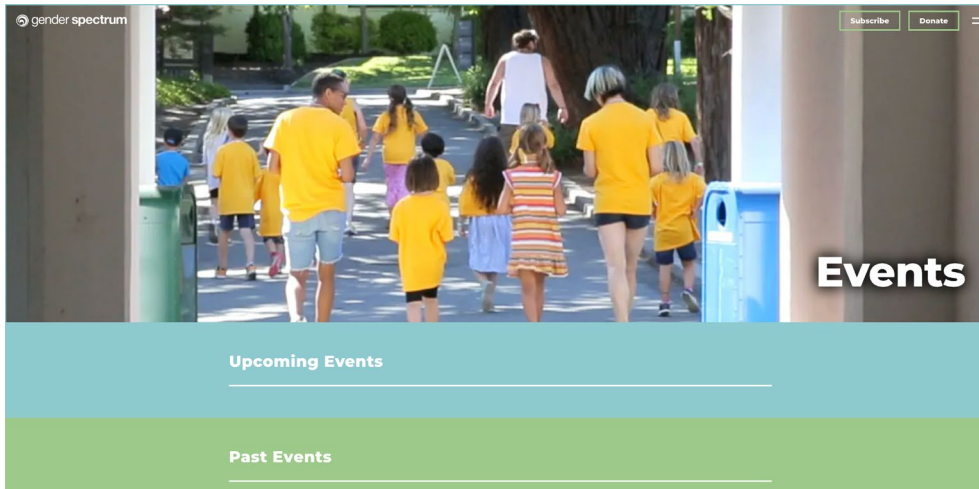
All of us are inundated with gender messages from the time we are born, but few of us take the time to reflect on and consider the effect that gender expectations have had on our lives. Our "My Gender Journey" exercise gives you a chance to explore your own gender story.

- *Interrupt* openly hostile attitudes or references towards others **EVERY TIME** you hear or observe them
- *Avoid using "normal"* to describe any behaviors.
- *Share personal anecdotes* from your own life that reflect a growing understanding of gender inclusiveness.

Facial Surgery (Gender Affirming Surgery Series)

Dr. Facque will be giving two different presentations back to back both on the topic of facial gender affirming surgery. In the first portion, Dr. Facque will discuss development of the facial skeleton during puberty, as an attempt to help explain the reasons why some seek facial surgery to relieve gender dysphoria. He will then talk about surgical options that are available to feminize facial features and some of the special considerations that are important for each procedure. In the second hour, Dr. Facque will then be discussing the surgical options that are available to help masculinize the face as well as relevant anatomy and details of those procedures.

This presentation will cover the surgical journey of a young patient as they navigate towards the goal of aligning their bodies with their identity in the form of vaginoplasty. It informs the patient and family/allies through various phases from online research, picking the right surgical team, preparing for the consultation as well as a description of the specific surgical approach that Dr. Ley performs. This is followed by a detailed description of the surgical procedure and an extensive dive into post operative care and long term expectations.

Top Surgery (Gender Affirming Surgery Series)

Dr. Mosser will be giving two different presentations back to back both on the topic of top surgery. In the first hour from 10-11am Dr. Mosser will talk about quite a few aspects of masculinizing top surgery which is often called transgender mastectomy surgery. He will talk about patient goals and priorities, anatomic variations, and the choices that patients need to make in order to pick a surgery that matches their goals and bodies as well as possible. He will also talk about challenges for patients and their families who are seeking top surgery, such as insurance approval process, and what aspects of the journey toward surgery are difficult for adolescents.

These activists have established the fundamental misconception that these parents are “unsafe and abusive”.

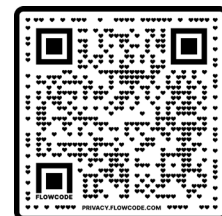
Parents: Schools have become indoctrination centers. Make courage a habit and take action.

PARENTAL RIGHTS 3-DAY NOTICE

I, _____, as parent and/or legal guardian of

_____, a minor child, am hereby providing notice that if you become aware, directly or indirectly, that my child has requested to be known by different pronouns, by a different name or otherwise communicates or exhibits behaviors that communicates a desire to transition gender or sex, you should notify me within three (3) business days of having learned such information. Notification should be attempted by at least two (2) different methods of communications (e.g., phone call, text, email, mail). Without my prior written consent, under no circumstances shall my child be referred to or engage with any on-staff school counselor, contracted school counselor, social worker, or any mental health professional.
